TOURNAMENT ENTRIES

BE Gold Tournaments are run by BADMINTON England (BE)

- Any grade & age of player may enter these but the target group is U17 Grade 1 and 2 players. Grade 1 players will be guaranteed entry into their own age group Gold circuit tournaments.
- Where the entry is over-subscribed, entries will be restricted according to condition 2.
- Games will be best of 3 to 21 points, using rally point scoring.

BADMINTON ENGLAND GOLD UNDER 17 INFORMATION

Gold tournaments may be run on behalf of BADMINTON England by County BAs. The tournaments are open to all players (see BADMINTON England website for details). Preliminary rounds of the singles and level doubles will be played in pools. The mixed doubles will normally be a knock-out event.

Gold tournaments are scheduled to be two-day events, which conclude on Sunday with the semi-finals and finals of all events. The order of play in each tournament may vary.

ENTRY FORMS:

- A separate entry form **MUST** be completed for each tournament.
- This completed form together with the correct entry fee must be sent to:
Competitions & Events Co-ordinator (Juniors), BADMINTON England, National Badminton Centre, Milton Keynes, MK8 9LA (01908 268400).
- Ensure that the forms are completed **CLEARLY** and in full (in particular the name of the specific tournament you are entering). Illegible or incomplete entries may be ignored.
- **Cheques must be made payable to 'BADMINTON England'**. Please do not abbreviate to 'BE'.
- Entry forms **MUST** be received by the Competitions & Events Co-ordinator (Juniors) by the entry closing date.
- **Late entries** will only be accepted at the Referee's discretion and if numbers permit. A late entry fee of £5.00 per player will be imposed. **In case of dispute**, the postmark may be used as evidence.
- The list of accepted players together with venue details and arrival times **will be posted on the BADMINTON England website** at least 7 days prior to the event. If you would like written confirmation then you must enclose a C5 stamped addressed envelope (229x162mm) with your entry. (Larger envelopes will require higher postage).
- **BOTH partners MUST submit an entry form.**
- If you have no partner and would like to enter a doubles event then write '**Partner Required**' in the space for 'Partner's Name'. The Tournament Committee will make every effort to find you a partner but cannot guarantee to do so.
- **Refunds** not dealt with directly at the tournament should be applied for in writing to the Competitions & Events Co-ordinator (Juniors) within one month of the date of the tournament.

ENTRY FEES: Boys & Girls Singles £14-00; Level Doubles £13-00; Mixed Doubles £11-00.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. **Gold Under 17 tournaments are open to all players providing they were born on or after 1st January 1991.**
2. Where entry levels need to be restricted the Tournament Committee will use the following criteria:
 - No late entries will be accepted
 - Known form, using the ranking lists (singles only) on the BADMINTON ENGLAND website on the closing date for entries. Doubles will be restricted if necessary by the Seeding Committee as in the past.
3. No tournament will start before 9.00am, or be scheduled to finish later than 7.00pm on the Sunday.
4. No player will be required to start a match after 9.00pm on a Saturday.
5. **Provided that at least 36 hours notice is given to the Tournament Secretary**, competitors who may be prevented from playing by illness or injury, or other unforeseen cause, shall have their entry fees returned, less £5 handling charge. The Tournament committee shall have the right to enquire into the cause of the withdrawal and withhold any refund.
6. All tournaments are run in accordance with BE Regulations. Clothing must be acceptable Badminton clothing and its suitability, within the regulations, will be at the discretion of the Referee.
7. Games will be best of 3 to 21 rally points extended to 30 if required.
8. All semi-finalists will receive a medal.
9. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to cancel a tournament and/or amend these conditions; in particular, the format of play if circumstances dictate. Any amendments will be notified to entrants.
10. BADMINTON England require that all players and attendees at their Tournaments agree to abide by BADMINTON England policies and codes of conduct, and as such fully recognise and adhere to the principles of the BADMINTON England Child Protection Policy.
11. Whilst every effort will be made to check all entry forms, it is ultimately the responsibility of the player to ensure that they comply with entry regulations.
12. **Yehlex feather shuttlecocks will be used exclusively in Gold Tournaments.**
